

# BLUE MOUNTAINS

As a professional photographer Matt's work has been sold and displayed to companies and private collectors around the world. He has commercial contracts with calender companies and has shot for the NSW Tourism and other government departments. His work is featured in numerous tourism and private promotional printed media and web sites.

Shooting on both slide film and pro digital on a daily basis Matt has a wealth of knowledge and techniques to not only make you a better photographer but to make you a photographer who can make each trip out in the field a learning experience.

It is these teachings on the how and why of photography that separate Matt's courses from the others. Not only does he want you to take a picture perfect postcard shot, he wants you to know how you took it.





This course is run totally on location in the Blue Mountains. The great outdoors will be our class room as the course is pitched for photographers of any level of experience from beginner to advanced.

The course will cover camera set up to the capture process to maximise image size, quality and sharpness so you can print your amazing shots as big as you want.

You will forget about settings such as “P” on your digital camera as you embrace and take your camera by the reins by manual shooting using the other settings as AV and TV to support manual shooting. For film photographers you will be taught to embrace the world of Velvia slide as you are taught the in’s and out’s of exposing this magical film.

Read and master dynamic light scenes while using in camera settings to create unique looks to your images.

This and so much more will be taught and experienced by you on the day. The joy and unexpected brilliance of landscape photography will be brought to your door step, where you take it after that is up to you. But you will have the training and understanding to make this world your oyster.



The course cost is \$440 and includes the following:

12 hours of photographic instruction.

Course booklet and DVD.

Transport around the Blue Mountains area.

BBQ lunch and drinks during the day.

The next course is running on the 20th of September 2008.

Places are limited to 8 per class.

Students will meet at the Three Sisters, Echo point for sunrise shoot from here we will venture to several new locations during the day.

The course will end at the Three Sisters, Echo Point for sunset shoot where you will be able to look at the same location you did at the start of the day and compare your new understanding of how to shoot it.
